Hydrogel Absorbent Sheets Wound Dressing

Simpurity™ Hydrogel Absorbent Sheet Wound Dressing can effectively absorb water and wound exudate as well as provide sufficient water content to dry wounds, to maintain a moist environment that promotes wound healing. The product is semi-transparent, so it is easy to observe the healing conditions of the wound. It will not stick to the wound and leaves no residue upon removal.

Application:

1. Clean the wound with sterile cleanser or saline water and dry the surrounding skin
2. Choose the right size of dressing to cover the wound according to wound area

Bordered Hydrogels:

1. Remove liners from the back side of the dressing
2. Apply the dressing to the wound
3. Once the dressing is in place, remove the backing films

Non-Bordered Hydrogels:

1. Remove liners from the back of the dressing
2. Apply the dressing to the wound bed

Changing Frequency:

It is recommended that the non-bordered hydrogel should be changed daily and the bordered dressing is recommended to be changed three (3) times a week.

For infected wounds, the product will not affect general or local drug administration

Indications:

Simpurity™ Hydrogel Absorbent Sheet Wound Dressings are applicable to partial thickness burns, splitting skin, donor sites, and epidermis defects resulting from other causes; leg venous ulcers, pressure ulcers and diabetic ulcers.

Contraindications:

The product is not indicated for full thickness burns and individuals who are hypersensitive to this dressing.
